

National Pregnancy in Diabetes audit:

helping to improve pregnancy care for women with pre-existing diabetes



Your antenatal diabetes clinic is taking part in an important project to check that women with pre-existing diabetes are being provided with good care during pregnancy.

This project is called the National Pregnancy in Diabetes (NPID) audit.

To take part in the NPID audit, your diabetes antenatal team will collect information about your pre-existing diabetes and your pregnancy. The data will be held on a secure electronic system. The collection, and use of such information, is strictly controlled by law and follows national standards of confidentiality and security.

By taking part in the NPID audit, this service shows that it is committed to improving the care of women with pre-existing diabetes who become pregnant.
