1.	<p><b>Introductions</b></p> <p>Panel members were welcomed to the meeting by the Chair, who also ran through the agenda.</p>
2.	<p><b>Formal noting of previous meeting's action notes</b></p> <p>The action notes from the 23 March 2023 meeting were agreed and approved for publication.</p>
3.	<p><b>Programme Update</b></p> <p>The Head of Communications for the GDPR Programme gave an update on the overall progress of the programme and update and confirmed that a summary of the programme progress has been submitted to the GDPR board. It was agreed a copy of the paper would be shared with Panel members.</p> <p>An update was also provided about the ambient data campaign. Matt Howard Murray offered to facilitate introductions with some research charities, to support the delivery of the campaign and this will be followed up outside of the meeting.</p> <p>It was queried why the write up of the PPECAP away-day has not been published. It was confirmed that the key points are on today's agenda for agreement with the Panel. Following that, they will be written into a report, however they can't be published during the pre-election period. The useMYdata representative expressed his frustration with the delay in the publication.</p>
4.	<p><b>Away Day Write-up</b></p> <p>A summary of the key points of the write-up was given by the Head of Communications and they were agreed by the panel.</p> <p>The report will now be finalised and circulated to the panel.</p>
5.	<p><b>Review of focus group feedback</b></p> <p>The GDPR team conducted some focus groups to explore public views towards a range of GP data models and the findings were shared with the panel. Due to time constraints it was agreed that the update be split across two</p>

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	<p>meetings. The slides will be circulated ahead of the meeting for review by the panel.</p> <p>Confusion with the opt-outs was noted again by the Panel. It was agreed the findings would be shared with other teams to inform their work, for the future opt-out review by the policy team.</p> <p>It was suggested, by a panel member, that the findings of the focus group highlight the value of having an ongoing conversation with the public.</p>
<p>6.</p>	<p><b>AOB</b></p> <p>It was noted that Rebecca Moore is leaving Healthwatch and therefore no longer the Chair for the PPECAP. This will be her last meeting. A replacement will be communicated to the panel shortly.</p> <p>The Panel thanked Rebecca for her time and her contributions to the PPECAP.</p> <p>The next PPECAP meeting will be on the 11<sup>th</sup> of May due to availability of the GDPR team on the 27<sup>th</sup> of April 2023 and so this session will be cancelled.</p> <p>No further points were raised.</p>
