

# Corrigendum

## Background

DAPB0092 Amd 64/2020 was published on 15 June 2021.

Since then, the need for corrections to the data set has been identified. A summary is provided below.

Note that there is no impact on the published Requirements Specification, Change Specification or the Implementation Guidance. However, an updated [Technical Output Specification \(TOS\) has been issued](#) and should be read in conjunction with this Corrigendum.

## Summary

Eight corrections are required across the TOS as follows.

### **In CDS Admitted Patient Care Types 120, 130, 140, 180, 190, 200 (HOSPITAL PROVIDER SPELL - DISCHARGE CHARACTERISTICS data group):**

1. The data item description for DISCHARGE READY DATE has been changed, from

'Discharge Ready Date is the date that a PATIENT was medically ready for discharge from a Hospital Bed but could not be discharged, thereby qualifying for Delayed Discharge Payments under the provisions of the Community Care (Delayed Discharges etc) Act 2003.'

to

'Discharge Ready Date is the date that a PATIENT no longer met the 'Criteria to Reside' in a Hospital Bed. Note that Discharge Ready Date is not the same as the Estimated Discharge Date (Hospital Provider Spell) and is recorded separately.

The status of a PATIENT within a Hospital Provider Spell who is awaiting discharge may change from no longer meeting the 'Criteria to Reside' in a Hospital Bed, to once again meeting the 'Criteria to Reside' in a Hospital Bed, if the clinical condition of the PATIENT deteriorates while awaiting discharge for any reason.'

This change has been made to ensure that the data item can be utilised to record the date at which people no longer meet the 'Criteria to Reside'. The new definition

replaces the previous version, which was based on the provisions of the now repealed Community Care (Delayed Discharges etc) Act 2003. NHS England and NHS Improvement will release additional guidance via [the NHS Futures website](#) covering specific scenarios that may affect how the DISCHARGE READY DATE is recorded for specific patients.

**In the CDS Outpatient Type 020 - CARE REFERRAL  
(MISSED APPOINTMENT OCCURRENCE data group):**

2. The data item description for LAST PATIENT DID NOT ATTEND DATE has been changed, from

‘For the CDS V6-3 Type 020 - Outpatient Commissioning Data Set, the LAST PATIENT DID NOT ATTEND DATE is the last APPOINTMENT which the PATIENT failed to attend without advance warning, on or prior to the APPOINTMENT DATE carried in that CDS V6-3 Type 020 - Outpatient Commissioning Data Set record.’

to

‘For the CDS V6-3 Type 020 - Outpatient Commissioning Data Set, the LAST PATIENT DID NOT ATTEND DATE is the last APPOINTMENT within a Consultant Out-Patient Episode which the PATIENT failed to attend without advance warning, on or prior to the APPOINTMENT DATE carried in that CDS V6-3 Type 020 - Outpatient Commissioning Data Set record.’

3. The data item description for LAST PATIENT CANCELLED DATE has been changed, from

‘For the CDS V6-3 Type 020 - Outpatient Commissioning Data Set, the LAST PATIENT CANCELLED DATE is the last APPOINTMENT which the PATIENT cancelled, on or prior to the APPOINTMENT DATE carried in that CDS V6-3 Type 020 - Outpatient Commissioning Data Set record.’

to

‘For the CDS V6-3 Type 020 – Outpatient Commissioning Data Set, the LAST PATIENT CANCELLED DATE is the last APPOINTMENT within a Consultant Out-Patient Episode which the PATIENT cancelled, on or prior to the APPOINTMENT DATE carried in that CDS V6-3 Type 020 – Outpatient Commissioning Data Set record.’

These two changes have been made, as result of data submitter feedback, to clarify that each data item applies to appointments within the same Consultant Episode.

**In CDS Types 130 and 190  
(PRIMARY DIAGNOSIS and SECONDARY DIAGNOSIS data groups)**

4. The data item description for PRESENT ON ADMISSION INDICATOR has been changed, from

'Note: PRESENT ON ADMISSION INDICATOR is only required for PATIENTS with a PATIENT DIAGNOSIS relating to a pre-existing pressure ulcer before admission to a Health Care Provider, recorded as an ICD-10 CODE. This is to allow sufficient time for Health Care Providers to move to using the SNOMED CT -coded Comorbidity data structure to submit this data in CDS V6-3 Type 130 - Admitted Patient Care - Finished General Episode Commissioning Data Set / CDS V6-3 Type 190 - Admitted Patient Care - Unfinished General Episode Commissioning Data Set, which is the preferred mechanism of data submission.'

to

'Note: PRESENT ON ADMISSION INDICATOR is only required for PATIENTS with a PATIENT DIAGNOSIS relating to a pre-existing Pressure Ulcer or Venous Thromboembolism (VTE) before admission to a Health Care Provider, recorded as an ICD-10 CODE. This is to allow sufficient time for Health Care Providers to move to using the SNOMED CT-coded Comorbidity data structure to submit this data in CDS V6-3 Type 130 - Admitted Patient Care - Finished General Episode Commissioning Data Set / CDS V6-3 Type 190 - Admitted Patient Care - Unfinished General Episode Commissioning Data Set, which is the preferred mechanism of data submission.'

This data item was updated in CDS v6.3 to specifically reference the capture of data relating to pre-existing pressure ulcers acquired before admission to hospital. The description of this data item is now being updated further to also reference pre-existing Venous Thromboembolism (VTE).

This amendment is designed to support NHS England and NHS Improvement in pilot work around hospital-associated conditions. This pilot work will contribute to the intended development of a separate information standard to drive the future completion and submission of this information, with the eventual intention to use SNOMED CT codes to capture this information.

**In CDS Types 020, 120, 130, 140, 150, 160, 180, 190, 200  
(SERVICE AGREEMENT DETAILS data group)**

5. The data item SPECIALISED SERVICE CODE has been replaced with the updated data item [SERVICE CODE](#).

This change has been made at the request of NHS England and NHS Improvement, to ensure alignment with [the national Contract Monitoring data sets](#).

**In CDS Types 020, 120, 130, 140, 180, 190, 200  
(PERSON GROUP - CARE PROFESSIONAL data group)**

6. The required status of the data item CARE PROFESSIONAL MAIN SPECIALTY CODE has been changed from

'M' (Mandatory)

to

'R' (Required)

This change has been made because certain types of non-consultant care professionals can now be submitted through the PERSON GROUP (i.e., pharmacists) do not have a suitable default Main Specialty Code, so the item cannot be mandated.

Please note that the CARE PROFESSIONAL MAIN SPECIALTY CODE data item is still mandatory from a Healthcare Resource Group (HRG) perspective. If the submitted Main Specialty Code in the record is not a valid recognised code in the Casemix design database, the spell will U group and generate the UZ01Z HRG, 'Data Invalid for Grouping'.

**In CDS types 020, 130 and 190 (EMED3 FIT NOTE data group)**

7. The data item EMED3 FIT NOTE ISSUER has been added.

This data item will be used to denote the profession of the staff member who issued the fit note and will appear in the CDS tables as text (an2) but will be notated with a mandation level of 'X' (not for submission yet). This will allow for the new field to be 'activated' in the future, without the need to update and release a new schema version.

A note will be added to the NHS Data Model and Dictionary to inform users that this item has not been approved by the DAPB and should not be submitted until further development by NHS Digital has been undertaken.

This data item has been introduced to align with the forthcoming DAPB4011 eMED3 (Fit Notes) in Secondary Care information standard, and similar changes in primary care.

**In CDS headers – types 005B and 005N**

8. A change has been made to the national codes for TYPE 005B PROTOCOL IDENTIFIER CODE and TYPE 005N PROTOCOL IDENTIFIER CODE:

This change has been made to align the TOS with the XML schema (issued separately by NHS Digital) and the NHS Data Model and Dictionary Change Request. This change ensures that only the applicable national codes are now included in the CDS PROTOCOL IDENTIFIER CODE for the relevant CDS submission type (i.e., bulk or net).

## Further information for users, outside of the scope of this corrigendum:

1. The CDS v6.3 XML schema (not a DAPB product but issued separately by NHS Digital) has been re-issued as CDS v6.3.1. This is to accommodate several of the changes described in this Corrigendum, but also includes updates to field lengths for certain data items from 'n3' to 'max n3' to match the NHS Data Model and Dictionary and TOS. The affected fields in **CDS Types 120, 130, 140, 180, 190, 200 (ACTIVITY CHARACTERISTICS data group)** are:

In addition, in CDS Types 150 and 160 the BirthEpisode structure has been amended from 'mandatory' to 'required' through adding a 'minOccurs' tag to the data element. This change has been made because all the data items within this structure are 'required' or 'optional' and will ensure that submissions which contain no BirthEpisode structure will not be rejected.

Please note that the updated field lengths and other changes to support this corrigendum were initially included in a CDS v6.3.0 release of the schema, but this has now been superseded by CDS v6.3.1 which includes the BirthEpisode change.

2. While not a formal change to the published information standard, the developers would like to confirm that an updated list of legally restricted codes, including SNOMED CT codes, is under development. Once released, it is expected that these codes will be used by NHS Digital to restrict the onward dissemination of identifiable information where it relates to legally restricted information (such as information covered by the Gender Recognition Act or Human Fertilisation and Embryology Act).

This planned change will not result in any changes to the published ISN, TOS or other supporting documents but has been referenced in this corrigendum for care provider, system supplier and middleware supplier awareness and to aid future planning. Further guidance will be released alongside the updated list of legally restricted codes to clarify the requirements for data submitters.
