Description	<p>This information standard provides a set of requirements suitably structured to promote and ensure the effective application of clinical risk management by health and care organisations deploying and using Health IT Systems.</p> <p>The standard forms part of the NHS Digital Clinical Safety Standards; it is accompanied by the related standard for the application of clinical risk management in the manufacture of Health IT Systems (DCB0129).</p>
About this change	<p>Following the publication of the Medical Devices Regulation (EU 2017/745) in May 2017 and evidence of the need for clinical risk assessment of medical devices using software, a decision has been made to extend the scope of the standard to now include medical devices.</p> <p>Previously medical devices have been excluded from the scope of the Clinical Safety Standards.</p>

Applies to	This information standard is addressed to health organisations that are responsible for ensuring clinical safety in the deployment, use, maintenance or decommissioning of Health IT Systems through the application of clinical risk management.
