Background:

This Change Request updates the definition of the 'GS1 Global Service Relation Number', to support the publication of [DAPB0108 Automatic Identification Data Capture \(AIDC\)](#).

Note that this amendment to the NHS Data Model and Dictionary does not change the published standard [DCB1077: AIDC for Patient Identification](#).

GS1 GLOBAL SERVICE RELATION NUMBER

Change to Supporting Information: Changed Description

A [GS1 Global Service Relation Number](#) identifies the relationship between a [Health Care Provider](#) and a [PATIENT](#), for the purposes of the [AIDC for Patient Identification Data Set](#). A [GS1 Global Service Relation Number](#) is the GS1 Identification Key used to identify the relationship between a [SERVICE](#) provider and a [SERVICE](#) recipient. To limit privacy concerns, a [GS1 Global Service Relation Number](#) can only identify a business or individual in the context of the [SERVICE](#) relation.

A [GS1 Global Service Relation Number](#) consists of: For the [AIDC for Patient Identification Data Set](#), the [GS1 Global Service Relation Number](#) relates to the recipient of the [SERVICE](#) to identify the relationship between a [Health Care Provider](#) and a [PATIENT](#), and consists of:

- [GS1 UNIQUE ORGANISATION PREFIX NUMBER](#)
- [NHS NUMBER](#)
- [GS1 GLOBAL SERVICE RELATION NUMBER CHECK DIGIT](#).
- [GS1 GLOBAL SERVICE RELATION NUMBER CHECK DIGIT](#)

Note that the [GS1 Global Service Relation Number](#) may also relate to the provider of a [SERVICE](#), to identify the relationship between an [ORGANISATION](#) and providers of healthcare [SERVICES](#), such as [Care Workers](#) or other [CARE PROFESSIONALS](#). However this representation is not currently used for any existing NHS data sets.
