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# 1. Overview

This product precisely defines the patient level Mental Health Services Data Set (MHSDS) standard.

The Summary section below describes the standard; the Requirements and Conformance Criteria sections explain what is required of care providers and systems to conform to the standard, and how conformance is tested.

Description	<p>The MHSDS is a patient level, output based, secondary uses data set which aims to deliver robust, comprehensive, nationally consistent and comparable person-based information for all patients who are in contact with Mental Health Services.</p> <p>The Mental Health Services Data Set covers services located in England or located outside England but treating patients commissioned by an English Integrated Care Board (ICB), NHS England specialised commissioner or an NHS-led Provider Collaborative.</p> <p>As a secondary uses data set, the MHSDS re-uses clinical and operational data for purposes other than direct patient care. It defines the data items, definitions and associated value sets extracted or derived from local information systems.</p> <p><b>In Scope</b></p> <p>All activity relating to patients of <b>any age</b> who receive care for a suspected or diagnosed mental health and wellbeing need, Learning Disability, autism or other neurodevelopmental conditions is within scope of the MHSDS.</p> <p>It may be that the person has:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A mental health need or is being supported for their mental wellbeing including; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Gambling addiction and substance misuse</li> <li>○ Children and young people’s mental health services</li> <li>○ Mental health support teams working in schools and colleges</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Any combination of mental health, Learning Disability or autism needs</li> </ul>

	<p><b>Out of Scope</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Adult Improving Access to Psychological Therapies (IAPT) services, now known as NHS Talking Therapies for anxiety and depression, are currently out of scope of the MHSDS as this activity is covered by the IAPT data set.</li> </ul>
<p>Dataset submission requirements by location and funding source</p>	<p>Record level data submission requirements for each patient accessing services, based on location and funding source, are as follows;</p> <p><b>Services in England:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the care for the patient is wholly funded by the NHS – data submission for that patient is mandatory.</li> <li>If the care for the patient is partially funded by the NHS – data submission for that patient is mandatory.</li> <li>If the care for the patient is wholly funded by any means that is not NHS – data submission is optional.</li> </ul> <p><b>Services outside England:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the patient is attending a service located outside England, but commissioned by an English ICB, NHS England specialised commissioner or an NHS-led Provider Collaborative, data submission is optional but may be a requirement of the commissioning arrangements.</li> <li>For example, this would include providers that are near English borders that routinely provide services to English patients and are claiming funding from English commissioners.</li> </ul>

However, these lists may not be comprehensive considering evolving models of care delivery.</p> <p>Services covered by the data set scope but not appearing in these data item lists must identify themselves against the most appropriate code available.</p> <p>The following service types are also included within the scope;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NHS commissioned mental health services delivered within or to support primary care (excluding adult IAPT)</li> <li>• <a href="#">New models of community mental health services</a> integrated with primary care</li> </ul> <p><b>Departments</b></p> <p>The standard must be read and used by all heads of mental health, Learning Disabilities and autism services, and other clinical and support services, including community services, that have an active involvement in delivering secondary mental health care.</p> <p><b>Professionals</b></p> <p>The standard applies to all professions working in or supporting mental health, Learning Disabilities and autism services and other services offering secondary mental health care including community services. The MHSDS Technical Output Specification (TOS) provides information about the types of care professionals that are within the scope of this information standard (see MHS901 Staff Details table within the TOS).</p> <p><b>IT Systems</b></p> <p>The standard predominantly, but not exclusively, relates to clinical systems designed to support mental health, learning disabilities and autism services, Patient Administration Systems (PAS) and Electronic Patient Records (EPR).</p>
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IG, Linkage and Data Use	<p>The data held in the MHSDS will be made available within NHS England for analysis, and also for other arm’s-length bodies, NHS-funded mental health service providers and commissioners and the wider mental health community. This is to support research and innovation, and understand the impact of mental health care on patient outcomes and experiences.</p> <p>Requests for data from the MHSDS will be managed through NHS England’s Clear Data Access Tools and <a href="#">Data Access Request Service (DARS)</a>.</p> <p>Information will be published in line with NHS England’s duty to publish under section 260(1) of the Health and Social Care Act 2012, unless it falls within section 260(2) of the Act. Further information can be found on the NHS England data security <a href="#">webpages</a>.</p> <p>Mental health data may also be linked to data held by NHS England from various other data sets, collections and population health surveys to provide richer information to enhance existing and develop new publications and insights, to reduce burden on submitters and to respond to requests for data and information. ## 2. Background and justification for release

The MHSDS applies to, and is used by, a wide range of stakeholders for various secondary uses purposes. As such, the MHSDS data set is regularly reviewed and updated in response to changes in policy and to ensure that stakeholders' requirements continue to be met with minimal burden for data submitters.

NHS England maintain the content of the data set through consultation with these stakeholders, which include various sections of NHS England, Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC), Care Quality Commission (CQC), service providers, IT system suppliers and commissioners.

Changes are required to the MHSDS v6.0 to ensure that the data set remains fit for purpose. The following amendments are required in response to changes in clinical practice or coding, changes to policy requirements, changes to the NHS Data Model and Dictionary in response to other information standards, and requests for amendments by care providers or system suppliers.

A maintenance strategy has been agreed with the Mental Health Data and Information Programme Board for NHS England to facilitate annual updates of the data set. This release represents the third annual update in this development cycle. Please see section 6 of the Implementation Guidance for full details of the maintenance strategy.

Further details on these drivers and justification for the changes being made to the data set are outlined below.

### 3. Detail of changes

This section provides additional detail in relation to the individual changes made to the data set in support of the high-level drivers. The TOS fully defines the individual changes applied to the data set, with each change logged in the 'Change Control' tab.

#### 3.1. Removed data tables and their associated data items

This section details the removal of the pilot Mental Health Currency Model table, the Care Programme Approach tables and the Care Cluster tables and their respective data items.

These changes were made to reduce burden by removing data fields which are no longer included in national policy and are no longer required for secondary uses and analysis.

A total of 8 tables were removed, containing 38 data items in total, all of which were subject to consultation.
