Standard definition	
Description	<p>The National Workforce Data Set (NWD) is a reference data standard containing standardised definitions to facilitate the capture of nationally consistent information relating to the NHS and wider healthcare workforce.</p> <p>NWD data items support a variety of workforce collections and are also embedded within HR/workforce IT systems, including the Electronic Staff Record (ESR) and NHS Jobs.</p> <p>The NWD is maintained by the Workforce Statistics team within NHS Digital.</p>
About this change	<p>Version 3.1 of the National Workforce Data Set has been updated to support national policy and programmes, as well as to ensure values are kept current. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• new values within Job Role and Area of Work to support:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ social prescribing in primary care○ expansion of mental health services• a new value to support the accurate recording of Emergency Call Handlers and Emergency Medical Dispatchers• a new value to support the proposed regulator for social care in England - Social Work England (affecting Job Role, Occupation Code, Area of Work, Professional Registration Body and Registration Type)• the renaming of existing values within elements (affecting Job Role, Occupation Code, Area of Work and Registration Type). <p>In addition, presentational/guidance updates to the NWD specification and guidance documents have been made which do not materially impact on the individual values described by the NWD.</p>

However, the NHS in Wales also uses the standard and is encouraged to do so.</p>
Impacts upon	Implementation of this information standard impacts all health workforce related IT systems suppliers providing systems to the above providers; suppliers should work with their customers to determine necessary changes.
