Background

The current release of DCB1520 Improving Access to Psychological Therapies (IAPT) Data Set was published on 5 September 2019.

Since then the need for a minor correction to the data set has been identified. A summary is provided below.

Note that there is no impact on either the published Requirements Specification or the Implementation Guidance. However an updated Change Specification and Data Set Specification have been issued and should be read in conjunction with this Corrigendum.

Summary

Four corrections are required across the Data Set Specification and Change Specification.

Changes in the Data Set Specification and the Change Specification:

1. An INTEGRATED IMPROVING ACCESS TO PSYCHOLOGICAL THERAPIES LONG TERM CONDITION SERVICE INDICATOR data item has been added to the IDS201CareContact table.

This change has been made to support the requirement to migrate the separate Long Term Conditions (LTC) and Medically Unexplained Symptoms (MUS) pilot collection into the IAPT Data Set. Full details of the new data item are available in the Data Set Specification.

Changes in the Data Set Specification only:

1. The group-level notes for IDS004 Employment Status are changed from:

‘One occurrence of this group is permitted, containing the most recently recorded employment details’

to

‘One occurrence of this group is permitted for each employment status’

This ensures alignment with the Mental Health Services Data Set (DCB0011) and the Community Services Data Set (DCB1069).

2. In the IDS001 Master Patient Index table, the UID for Ex-British Armed Forces Indicator is changed from:

I005100

to

I001140

This is to correct a production error.

3. The format for DURATION OF INTERNET ENABLED THERAPY IMPROVING ACCESS TO PSYCHOLOGICAL THERAPIES CARE PROFESSIONAL CLINICAL TIME has been changed from:

'man n4'

to

'max n4'

This is to correct a spelling error.
