#### T AND B CUTANEOUS LYMPHOMA (NON-MYCOSIS FUNGOIDES OR SÉZARY SYNDROME)

<b>T and B Cutaneous Lymphoma (non-Mycosis Fungoides or Sézary syndrome)</b>	
<b>T – Primary Tumour</b>	
<b>cT1</b>	Solitary lesion <b>cT1a</b> - <5 cm in diameter <b>cT1b</b> - ≥5 cm in diameter
<b>cT2</b>	Multiple lesions limited to one body region or two contiguous body regions <b>cT2a</b> – All disease <15 cm in diameter <b>cT2b</b> – All disease ≥15 cm to <30 cm in diameter <b>cT2c</b> – All disease ≥30 cm in diameter without extending beyond 2 contiguous body regions
<b>cT3</b>	Generalised disease <b>cT3a</b> – Multiple lesions involving two non-contiguous body lesions <b>cT3b</b> – Three or more body regions involved
<b>N – Regional Lymph Nodes</b>	
<b>cN0</b>	No clinically abnormal peripheral lymph nodes
<b>cN1</b>	Involvement of 1 peripheral nodal region that drains the area of involved skin
<b>cN2</b>	Involvement of ≥2 peripheral node regions or involvement of any node region that does not drain the area of involved skin
<b>cN3</b>	Involvement of central node on biopsy
<b>M – Distant Metastasis</b>	
<b>cM0</b>	No visceral involvement
<b>cM1</b>	Visceral involvement
