<b>Section 1: Collection</b>	<p><i>Please give a short explanation of the processes through which the system's underlying 'raw data' are captured.</i></p> <p>KC61 data is collected from Pathology Laboratories by the Regional Quality Assurance Co-ordinators (QARCs), who aggregate the data for their region before forwarding on to the HSCIC. The HSCIC collect the data from the QARCs on a series of Excel spreadsheets via a secure online portal called Data Depot.</p>
<b>Section 2: Quality assurance</b>	<p><i>Please give details of any arrangements for auditing the quality of administrative data from this system which is used for statistical purposes</i></p> <p>The NHS Cancer Screening Programmes employs a network of Regional Quality Assurance Co-ordinators who ensure that the data entered into the system is accurate and timely. The QARCs validate the data on the KC61 at time of collection.</p>
