## **Announcement of methodological change to “Statistics on Smoking, England 2014”**

In previous years this publication has presented analysis of data from the General Lifestyles Survey (GLF) which is conducted by the Office for National Statistics (ONS). The GLF was discontinued after the 2011 survey although a small number of questions on smoking were carried over to the Opinions and Lifestyles Survey (OPN) which is also conducted by ONS. Therefore not all the tables and charts previously produced from the GLF can be produced from OPN data.

In addition, HSCIC previously received pre-release access to the underlying GLF data so they could reanalyse the survey data to produce results for England rather than using the GB level results which were published by ONS. This pre-release access has not been carried forward to the OPN and therefore, the coverage of all the charts and tables using OPN data will be at GB level.
