

GP Approach to submitting to Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) Enhanced Dataset

1 Aim

There are three different approaches which can be followed by GPs to record, extract and submit information to the FGM Enhanced Dataset as described in the [Data Provision Notice](#)

The number of patients seen in the practice who have had FGM is likely to determine which of the following three options shown below is chosen.

Whichever option is chosen a designated member of the practice team will need to register with NHS Digital to gain access to the secure clinical audit platform (CAP) to submit data on FGM by following this link [FGM - Clinical Audit Platform](#). The registration process is documented on the registration form.

2 Collecting and recording information on patient record

Templates have been developed by some system suppliers (for example TPP/SystemOne and EMIS) to support the recording, of relevant information on patient records. TPP have developed reports that can then be extracted from your clinical system and used to submit to the FGM Enhanced Dataset onto CAP via File Submission Dashboard. The templates do not have to be used by every general practice.

It may be decided locally to collect additional FGM-related information and therefore it is possible for organisations (GP or CCG level, dependent upon GP system of choice) to create local variations to the template for submitting data to NHS Digital.

Option 1

- Record FGM information on patients' healthcare record using available template in the clinical system
- Extract a report from the clinical system and enter the relevant information manually onto CAP.

This option may be preferred by most GP practices in areas of very low or low prevalence.

Option 2

- Record FGM information on patient's healthcare record using available template in the clinical system
- Extract 3 files/reports from the clinical system which are in the format required to upload electronically onto CAP
- A member of the practice team uploads the files directly into CAP following the instructions in the system supplier guidance and NHS Digital file upload instructions. [FGM Data - File upload in CAP](#)

This option may be chosen by GP practices in areas with a known prevalence of FGM.

Option 3

- Manually record information on the patients' health record
- Use a local in-house template, such as a paper data collection form or spreadsheet and enter manually into CAP

This option may be chosen by GP practices in areas with very low prevalence of FGM.
